Airfare:

Airfare to and from Nairobi is not included in the program fee. Please inquire about rates from your departure city. Global Colleges is usually able to arrange discount airfare because of group travel and student discounts.

Options:

Option 1: 2 weeks biology and environmental systems focus. Students may also elect to concentrate more on arts and culture. The two weeks will be followed by a 1 week safari. Students who select this option should arrange airfare to and from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO).

Option 2: 2 weeks of eco-tourism and community service in Uganda. Students who select this option should arrange airfare to and from Entebbe International Airport (EBB).

Option 3: Combines option 1 and option 2. Also includes travel between Nairobi and Kampala. Students who select this option should arrange airfare to and from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO).

Terms of application:

- Program space is limited due to restrictions on safari sizes. To guarantee spaces and prices, please observe the following payment procedures:
 - Application with deposit due by March 31, 2003
 - Full payment for all options is required by April 30, 2003
 - Deposits are non-refundable after the application due date of March 31, 2003
- **Please note that applications may still be considered beyond the application deadline.** However, the application deadline is in place to ensure that a space will be available for interested participants and to allow for participants to obtain the cheapest possible airfare.
- A full acceptance package and confirmation will be sent upon receipt of application and deposit.
- Price includes the deposit. Also included in the program price is pickup and drop-off at the respective airport. For students who cannot arrange travel on the arrival and departure dates, we can arrange hotel accommodation at the rate of \$100 US per day (inclusive of taxes and food).
